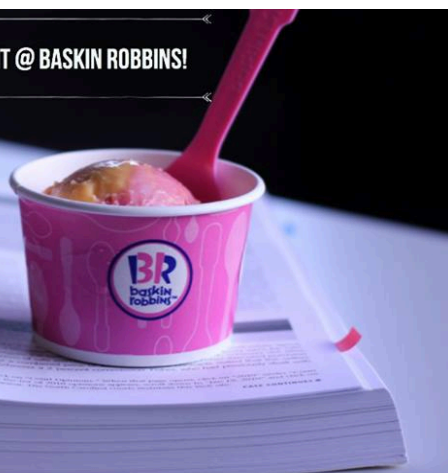

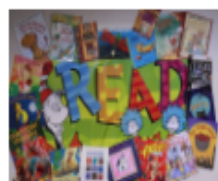

A Message from the Nurse

Dear Parents/Guardians:

All medication and diabetic supplies that have been left in the clinic for your student, need to be picked up no later than **June 8th, 2018**. Only students who have permission to self-carry their emergency medications, will be allowed to bring their medication home. All other students will not be able to pick up medications under any circumstances. They must be picked up by a parent or guardian. The district does not allow medication to be stored in the clinic over the summer so all medications not picked up by **noon on June 8th, 2018** will be disposed of properly or donated to organization below.

Austin Smiles is a nonprofit organization that sends medical personnel, equipment and supplies to third world countries for humanitarian aid.
